Re: Complaint - Krzystof Glowacki vs. Mairis Briedis

Dear Mr. Akhmedov:

I confirm receipt of your letter dated July 9<sup>th</sup> 2019. Please be advised that as a matter of Law, the World Boxing Organization (WBO) unfortunately, lacks jurisdiction to terminate, reverse or overrule an official bout result regarding a professional boxing contest held under the jurisdiction of a professional boxing commission. None of the recognized sanctioning organizations have legal power nor authority to determine such rulings thereto. Though all boxing contests sanctioned by any of the governing bodies are governed by their respective rules and regulations, it is the local boxing commissions' function to conduct and administer all professional boxing matches and therefore, bears jurisdiction and competence over said matters.

Regrettably, the World Boxing Organization pursuant to law, can only authorize ordering a rematch between the WBO Participants Glowacki and Briedis. Therefore, WBO is legally impaired to change the official bout result of the Glowacki vs. Briedis contest held in Riga, Latvia, on Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup> 2019.
